

## The Paris Peace Conference – a timeline of Key Events

8 January 1918	Wilson lays out the <a href="#">Fourteen Points</a> to the US Congress
11 November	<a href="#">Armistice</a> signed
18 January 1919	<a href="#">Peace Conference opens</a>
14 February	Wilson presents the draft of the League of Nations <a href="#">Covenant</a> (adopted 7 April, signed 28 April)
19 February	Clemenceau wounded in an assassination attempt
8 April	MPs remind Lloyd George of his promise to 'make Germany pay'
25 March	Lloyd George's <a href="#">Fontainebleau Memorandum</a> breaks the deadlock between Clemenceau and Wilson.
29 March	War Guilt Commission declares Germany responsible for the war
7 May	Finished draft sent to the Germans
16-24 May	German counterproposals considered and rejected
22 June	Allies threaten invasion if Germany does not sign
28 June	<a href="#">Treaty signed</a>
19 March 1920	The US Senate <a href="#">rejects</a> the Treaty of Versailles
